

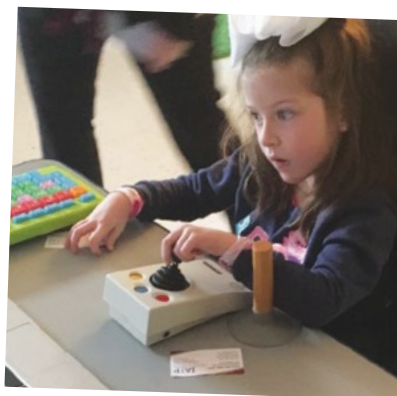

IATP also offers **6-week loans** of recommended devices and software at **no cost**, for trial and training to students, school personnel and families.
