


Orientation of the 9th Generation iPad





Turning On the iPad


- Hold down the **Power Button** to turn on the iPad.

Turning Off the iPad

- Hold down the Power Button to turn off the iPad.
- Slide **Slide to Power Off** to the right of the screen.





Overview of Pre-installed Apps - iPad

ConnectWise Control



ConnectWise Control allows individuals to review the screen of an iOS phone or tablet with the mobile app installed, allowing them to lead end users through troubleshooting, technical support, and more.

FaceTime



FaceTime is a free proprietary iOS app that allows the user to make and receive video calls over Wi-Fi. To complete FaceTime calls, you must call another user with the FaceTime app.

Zoom Cloud Meeting




ZOOM Cloud Meetings is a free iOS app that is a meeting platform app. ZOOM Cloud Meetings is a free app that will allow two parties to video chat and provides the ability to screen share. ZOOM Meetings with more than 3 participants are limited to 40-minute sessions.




Setting up Wi-Fi on the iPad

Tap the **Settings Icon**.








Tap Wi-Fi On.






Turn on Wi-Fi by sliding the circle to the right.






Choose a Wi-Fi Network.






Enter the network **Password**.










Press the **Home Button** to return to the home screen.





Tap the **Settings** Icon.








Tap Don't have an Apple ID or forgot it?








Fill in **First name**, **Last name**, and **Birthdate**, then tap **Next**.






Enter Email and tap Next.






Choose and enter a **Password**, **Verify** password, slide **agree to terms and conditions**, and tap **Next**.






Enter a telephone number that can be used to verify your account. Then tap **Text Message** or **Phone Call** for the code to be sent to you, then tap **Next**.






Enter the Code sent to your phone to verify your account, and tap **Next**.









Tap the **Settings Icon**.








Add phone number? Adding a phone number is optional Scroll down and tap **Skip** or you can enter a Phone Number and tap **Yes, I'm in**.

A **verification text** will be sent to your phone to confirm your phone number if you choose to enter it.













How to Use FaceTime on the iPad

Make a FaceTime Call Tap the FaceTime Icon.





Tap on **New FaceTime**.






Enter the phone number or email you are calling.

After entering the phone number or email address, tap the **video camera FaceTime Icon** to make the call.





This will be what the screen looks like while it is ringing...






... and when the FaceTime is **answered**.




To end the FaceTime, tap the **End Icon**.

To receive a FaceTime call when the iPad is asleep, slide **slide to answer** to the right.




To receive a FaceTime when the iPad is awake/in use, tap **Accept** or **Decline**.

Tap the **Zoom Icon**.








Enter the **Meeting ID** provided to you.






After Meeting ID is entered, tap **Join**.






Enter Passcode you are provided with for the meeting, and tap **Continue**.





Tap **OK** to allow Zoom to have access to your devices on your local network.




Tap **OK** to allow Zoom to **Access your microphone**.






Tap **OK** to allow Zoom to **Send Your Notifications**.



Tap **WiFi** to hear others please join **audio**.




Tap **OK** to allow Zoom to use your **camera**.






Zoom Meeting will look like the screen below.






Tap **Leave Meeting** to end your participation in meeting.






How to Find Entertainment Apps

Tap on the **Apps Icon**.








Tap **Search** at the bottom of the screen.






Enter the name or type of the game for which you are searching.






After you have typed name or what kind of game you are looking for, tap on the one you want to try from the drop-down list.








Choose the games you want, and tap on the word GET.






Tap **Install**.






Enter your **Apple ID Password**. Tap **Sign In**.
